- Change tap washers
- Fix loose floor coverings
- Fencing repairs
- Assemble flat pack furniture
- Fit door chains and locks
- Replace light bulbs
- Fill cracks in and paint walls
- Install grab rails
- Hang blinds and curtain rails
- Minor paving repairs
- Install washing line or rotary lines

Please note: if you are a tenant your landlord may have responsibility for some of these repairs.

To qualify to use this service you must be either 60 years or over and/or living with a disability.

The charges are as follows (per hour):

- £9.60 - In receipt of a means tested benefit
- £18.00 - Not in receipt of a means tested benefit

Appointments will last maximum of 2 hours per job.

Means tested benefits: Guaranteed Pension Credit, Income based Employment Support Allowance, Council Tax Support (not single person discount) and Housing Benefit.
